

Works by Cope2 at Dorian Grey Gallery

Since the <u>Dorian Grey Gallery</u> opened in Manhattan's East Village last year, it has been home to quite a few artists whose principal canvas is the streets. Among these is Cope2 who has exhibited in the past year at Dorian Grey a range of pieces – from works on canvas to skateboard decks to designer bags — as multi-faceted as the artist. This Thursday marks the opening of **Resilient**, his first solo show there, featuring works on canvas and custom subway signs. The discordant cacophony of images on the invite is in sharp contrast to his skateboard decks that surfaced in Dorian Grey's most recent show.
